PALM SUNDAY: Sunday 24th is Palm Sunday, the first day of Holy Week. The solemn procession and blessing of palms will take place at the beginning of the 9am Mass. At the other Masses the blessing of the palms will take place in church. The Passion of Mark will be read. It is available digitally and in missals. Please join in the people's parts if you have them.

<u>HOLY THURSDAY:</u> Our Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday will begin at 7pm. The Holy Oils blessed by the bishop at the Chrism Mass will be received. Special Ministers of the Eucharist are invited to renew their commitment at this Mass. At the end of Mass there will be the procession to the Altar of Repose. There will be the opportunity for private prayer in the church until 9pm.

GOOD FRIDAY: The Good Friday service will begin at the usual time of 3pm, the 'ninth hour' at which Jesus died on the cross. If you have the text of the Passion of St John, you can join in the people's parts. The Liturgy of the Word concludes with the General Intercessions. There will be no individual veneration of the Cross, but the opportunity to venerate the Cross as a community. Holy Communion will be available at the end of the Service.

<u>HOLY SATURDAY – EASTER SUNDAY:</u> This is the high point of the liturgical year, our celebration that 'Christ has died! Christ is risen! Christ will come again!' We will begin the service at 7pm with the blessing of the fire and the lighting of the paschal candle. Candles will be provided for each person to be lit from the paschal candle. The Easter Proclamation or Exsultet will be sung. The Liturgy of the Word, with four Old Testament readings, will follow. The Alleluia will be sung and the Easter gospel proclaimed. The renewal of baptismal promises will be made at this Mass and at the other Masses on Easter Sunday. NB There will be no 5pm Mass on Easter Sunday.

STATIONS OF THE CROSS: Stations of the Cross will take place on Friday 22nd March at 7.pm

THE READINGS AT THE EASTER VIGIL: On Wednesday 20th March at 7 pm Fr Adrian will give a talk in the parish hall entitled 'The Readings at the Easter Vigil - the 'four nights' of salvation'. Refreshments will be available from 6.30 pm. All are welcome, especially our Readers, Special Ministers of the Eucharist and Catechists, and all who intend to be at the Easter Vigil, the most important service of the Church's year.

JUBILEE RECONCILIATION SERVICE: On Thursday 21st March at 7 pm we will have our Lenten Reconciliation Service. Several priests will be available to hear Confessions. Our Jubilee Year is an opportunity to move forward in a more positive and faith-filled way. To do this we may well need to be freed from past mistakes and the things which bind us. We will be joined by our Confirmation candidates, who are preparing to receive the Sacrament at the end of May. Please consider taking advantage of this opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation in preparation for Holy Week and Easter. Of course, each Saturday the Sacrament of Reconciliation is available in our Church from 11 am
